To mark a square, read a book that meets the criteria in the square that you have not read in the past. A book can only be used to mark one square. For example, if you read <u>Harry Potter and the Sorcerer's Stone</u>, you could mark "The first book in the series" or "A sci-fi or fantasy book", but not both. Fill in the Title and Author for each book to show which square you are marking for that book.

To get a "bingo", get five squares in a row: across (horizontal), down (vertical), or diagonally. A square can be used in more than one "bingo". For example, you can use the center square for both diagonal lines, the center vertical line, and the center horizontal lines; the same book gets counted in four "bingos".

Complete one presentation in the program/app of your choice (Prezi, Powerpoint, Powtoon, etc).

The presentation must include the reviews of your favorite fiction choice and your favorite non-fiction choice (two books!). 6th graders submit to Mrs. Lopez (<u>ilopez@stjamesmiami.net</u>), 5th graders submit to Ms. George (<u>tgeorge@stjamesmiami.net</u>). All presentation are <u>due the first day of school</u>.
